THE YELLOW SHEET

THE YELLOW SHEET is your detailed daily schedule that includes the time and room location for all conference happenings, plus a detailed map of the Hyatt Regency. Keep THE YELLOW SHEET handy along with this book; you'll need them both.

TRAINING OPTIONS

You have three options for power-packed training. **Deeper Learning Tracks** are four intense, 2-hour sessions for a total of eight hours focused on a specific topic. Lots of time to learn, interact, discuss, and apply. **Half-Tracks** are two 2-hour sessions (four hours total) on a variety of topics. The perfect alternative for digging deep while allowing more variety. **Workshops** are practical 2-hour sessions scheduled throughout the conference on a broad scope of subjects. It's the most flexible option.

MINISTRY CONVERSATIONS

These one-hour sessions of sharing, debriefing, and idea-swapping are focused around a specific topic. Each conversation is enriched by a panel of children's ministers and moderated by a seasoned expert with experience and insight. Bring your joys, your woes, your I-don't-knows...and unpack them with a group of new friends. All Ministry Conversations take place on Friday afternoon.
